A. Discernment (pgs 48-53)

1. Truth -vs- False Doctrine
2. Chew & Spit - Teach children to discern for themselves

B. ROAR (pgs 53-60) “Truth is powerful, and the most potent lies are wrapped in partial truth.”

R - Recognize the message (values, worldviews, character traits)

O - Offer discernment (affirm the good and reject the bad)

A - Argue for a healthier approach

R - Reinforce through discussion, discipleship, and prayer
